2019 TORONTO LABOUR DAY PARADE UPDATE

Information about this year's Toronto Labour Day Parade and Boat Cruise is as follows:

The parade start time is **9:00 am sharp, but you will need to arrive at Nathan Phillip Square by 7:30am for set-up and to pick up Boat wristbands for your Local members.**

Speeches and entertainment will be starting at 8:00 am at Nathan Phillip Square. National President Jerry Dias will be speaking, along with a number of invited guests.

Unifor will be marching South on Bay Street, West on Richmond Street, South on University Avenue to Lake Ontario, Queen's Quay. We have reserved boats that will take us on a three (3) hour cruise around Lake Ontario. During this cruise lunch and refreshments will be served and we will have entertainment. We will have fun activities for the children throughout the cruise.

We appreciate your participation in this important day for Labour and to making this year's parade a huge success for Unifor.

Boat Cruise:

Wristbands:

Wristbands will be available ONLY at Nathan Phillip Square for the cruise. The cost of the wristbands will be \$10 per person and only available through the Locals. Locals will be responsible for picking up the wristbands at Nathan Phillip Square and distributing them to their members. You must participate in the parade in order to get a wristband to board one of the vessels. They will not be given out at Queen's Quay.

Locals are asked to submit the number of participants that will be attending the parade and will require wristbands. **Please submit this to Kristine Vendrame at Kristine.Vendrame@unifor.org by Thursday August 15, 2019. Locals will be invoiced for the number of wristbands ordered so please be accurate on the number that you request.**


